Exhibition Overview

SculptHamptons on the Greens will present a curated selection of large-scale sculptures produced by contemporary artists working in bronze, steel, stone, wood, resin, fiberglass, and other materials. Situated in the scenic Greens of Water Mill—between Southampton and Bridgehampton and close to the Parrish Art Museum and Art Hamptons fairgrounds—this exhibition aims to attract a sophisticated, art-savvy audience during the peak Hamptons season.

- Two consecutive spring-to-fall seasons (Spring–Fall 2025 and Spring–Fall 2026)

- Sculptures must be suitable for extended outdoor display
- All exhibited works must be for sale

Collectors & Institutions Welcome Art collectors and institutions are invited to consign sculptures for exhibition and sale. Participation provides excellent exposure in a prestigious art destination.

Terms & Consignment Details

- Duration: Two consecutive spring-fall seasons (approx. May–October)
- Sales Commissions:
 - Artists: 20% commission on sale price
 - Collectors/Institutions: Customized commission
- Insurance & Installation:

Participants must provide liability and artwork insurance. Professional and safe Installation required.
- Curatorial & Logistical Support
 - SculptHamptons's curative committee approves and oversees all placements of sculptures
 - On-site coordination for sculpture installation
 - Artists/owners receive assistance with technical and promotional preparation
